6 Purpose of processing personal data	<p>Personal data is processed for the purpose of implementing the agreement between the data controller and the data subject and, where applicable, on the basis of the data subject's consent, in connection with and to enable orders, registrations, contacts, transactions, marketing, reporting and other customer relationship management measures.</p> <p>Purchase and transaction data processed in the register, as well as location information, can also be used for profiling and to target marketing measures and customer communications to the data subject's interest. Personal data is also processed in connection with the sending of the newsletter and participation in events and other marketing activities.</p>

9 Regular data sources	<p>Data is obtained from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the data subject himself/herself
10 Categories of recipients of personal data	<p>Register data may be shared within the organisation. In addition, register data is transferred to the specified processor.</p>
11 Regular disclosures of data	<p>Data will not be disclosed outside Orton Oy or the parties involved in the maintenance of the application related to its event management system, except in accordance with consent and regulations.</p>
12 Retention period	<p>Data is stored in the register until the person in the training register cancels his or her registration.</p> <p>A person in the training register can delete his or her data from the register by clicking on the link online (www.orton.fi) or in the training letters sent electronically.</p>
13 Rights of the data subject	<p>The data subject has the following rights:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Right of access to personal data (Article 16) ○ the data subject may submit an electronic request for information via the security mail found on the company's website <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ to send a request for information by letter • Right to rectification (Article 16) ○ the data subject may submit a written claim for rectification • Right to erasure (Article 17) ○ the data subject may request the erasure of data that is unnecessary or incorrect for the purpose of the register • Right to restriction of processing (Article 18) ○ the data subject may make a free-form claim, which is always processed on a case-by-case basis • Right to objection (Article 21) ○ the data subject may make a free-form claim, which is always processed on a case-by-case basis • Right to transfer data from one system to another (Article 20) ○ the data subject may make a free-form claim, which is always processed on a case-by-case basis <p>Instructions and mailing addresses can be found on Orton Oy's website.</p> <p>In certain situations, the data controller may, for justified reasons, refuse to comply with the data subject's claims on the grounds provided for by law.</p>
14 Transfer of data outside the EU or EEA	<p>Only with the consent of the data subject.</p>

15 Principles of register protection	The register is maintained as a technical record by the data controller or by an authorised party. The information system is protected by appropriate technical protection against external data breaches. Access to the register is monitored with user-specific usernames and passwords.
